**MINUTES OF THE WHITE RIVER SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 416
BOARD OF DIRECTORS' MEETING HELD MAY 25, 2016**

The meeting of the White River Board of Directors was called to order at 5:30 p.m. The pledge of allegiance was conducted. Under Roll Call, all were present. Under Approve Agenda, it was moved and seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

A representative from Sodexo informed the board that they will be gearing up over the summer, have met (or will meet) all of the support staff and principals before school lets out. They will be working with administrators and building staff to discuss potential changes. The board can expect two food service reports next year, both at the beginning and again at the end of the school year. There was opportunity for questions and answers.

Dr. Andrew Schwebke presented the first reading of the new Core Connections curriculum for middle school math. He shared an overview of the committee process and recommendations. He stated that the rationale for the recommendations included strong alignment with state standards, providing consistent support to students, a research based approach to homework, and providing a smooth transition from the elementary to the middle school math program. This curriculum was the consensus choice of the staff on the adoption committee.

Dr. Andrew Schwebke presented the first reading of the AP Psychology (2nd edition) text for the high school AP Psychology course. He shared an overview of the committee process and recommendations. He shared that the recommendation was based on instructor feedback from College Board and that these materials are the most widely adopted resources used by school districts to teach AP Psychology. The book is a perfect match to College Board's 14 unit outline.

Dr. Andrew Schwebke presented the first reading of the K-12 Health and Fitness adoption. He shared an overview of the two year committee process and steps that the group went through. He stated that the recommendations included focusing on providing material support for the currently adopted SPARK materials, release time for intentional unit planning, and adopting Focused Fitness and APEX at the High School. Additionally, he shared about purchasing heart rate monitors to support the fitness walking classes at the High School.
